## In Loving Memory: Merritt J. Zimmerman

Merritt J. Zimmerman, 90, died Sep. 11, 2014 in Marion, South Carolina. Known to club members as Zimmie or Mert, he was a member of the Allentown Hiking Club for 60 years and was an extremely active member and leader before his retirement from the US Postal Service and departure to the Carolinas.

Merritt was the last known survivor of the 1954 AHC reorganization hike. The next year he was elected vice president of the club, and in 1956 assumed the presidency; he served another term as president in 1963, and for eight and a half years, from June 1967-1975, Zimmie was our club treasurer.

Zimmie was an avid hiker, backpacker, and hike leader. He organized multi-club trips to hiking destinations such as Eagles Mere, LaPorte, Hamburg, and the Shenandoahs, and backpacked with the club in the Catskills. He spent his vacations hiking the Appalachian Trail.

In 1965, Zimmie began leading a series of Pennsylvania Appalachian Trail hikes, so that club members could have an organized opportunity to hike the trail in the state. In grateful recognition of his "unselfish and whole-hearted work on the Appalachian Trail hikes", Zimmie was presented with a watch. The Summer 1967 Happy Hiker noted that Zimmie always looked after his group, was always ready to do anyone a favor, and could climb like a "mountain goat."

When Supreme Court Justice William O. Douglas led a hike to Sunfish Pond in 1967 to highlight efforts to save the pond, Mert was one of the participants.

Zimmie was very active in trail work, leading and participating in maintenance trips and shelter work. He represented the club at Appalachian Trail Conference meetings. In 1961 he chaired the Exhibits at the Delaware Water Gap meeting.

In 1975, in recognition of his many and varied services to the Allentown Hiking Club and the hiking community, Zimmie was awarded Honorary Membership in AHC.

Mert was also active with Keystone Trails Association, serving as vice president from 1967-1975. He attended all KTA meetings, representing AHC. He was awarded Honorary Membership in KTA in 2006.

#### MEMBER OF THE APPALACHIAN TRAIL CONSERVANCY AND THE KEYSTONE TRAILS ASSOCIATION

The general public is invited to join us on hikes and other events. If a club or organization wishes to include one of our hikes as a formal activity on its schedule, we ask that it contact the leader in advance for permission. <u>Times listed are departure times</u>; please arrive at least 15 minutes before the listed time. Starting times are strictly observed and appropriate clothing and sturdy shoes/boots should be worn at all times.

Generally, our pace is moderate with opportunities for resting and sightseeing. Every attempt is made to assist and encourage hikers, but we cannot be responsible for their safety on the trail. Any rugged outdoor activity entails risk, and we expect all participants to rely on their own judgment and good sense to take care of themselves and know their limitations. Anyone under 18 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult. Hikers are expected not to lag too far behind the main party.

We car-pool as much as possible to save fuel. PASSENGERS PAY DRIVERS 10 CENTS PER MILE TO DEFRAY FUEL EXPENSE. Drivers, please remember to check your mileage and let the passengers know how much mileage reimbursement they owe you.

Meetings are held at 7:30 pm the first Wednesday of the month at St. Timothy's Lutheran Church, 140 South Ott Street, Allentown, Pa. Meetings include a discussion of the previous month's activities, as well as upcoming activities. Scheduling meetings are held quarterly for members to coordinate hikes/trips, etc. for the upcoming schedule. All members are invited and encouraged to schedule activities; we are a 100% volunteer organization, and it is up to members to keep the schedule filled.

#### AHC HIKE RATING SYSTEM

In an attempt to assist hikers, a hike rating system has been set up to allow the hiker to judge his/her ability to complete the hike. The rating system will precede the Allentown Hiking Club's usual hike description. On multi-day outings such as backpacks, the rating for the hike will reflect the distance traveled on a per-day basis. Remember that the hike ratings are assigned by the hike leader, and are therefore based on the leader's subjective opinion.
